By application accepted for filing October 26, 2001, North Potomac Limousine, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one vehicle. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly rates and rates for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 30, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 21, 2001, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is December 21, 2001, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Jeffrey Brockman, 924 Beacon Square Court, #126, Gaithersburg, MD 20878.
