By application accepted for filing November 29, 2001, RMA Coach, LLC, a Maryland limited liability company, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing hourly-rate operations with five minibuses to be leased from Errands Plus, Inc., trading as RMA Chauffeured Transportation Service, WMATC No. 287. Applicant and Errands Plus, Inc., are both owned by Robert M. Alexander.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation and common control are consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than December 19, 2001, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than January 9, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is January 9, 2002, and that copies must be served on applicant's vice president, David R. Nock, 6010 Executive Boulevard, Suite 101, Rockville, MD 20852.
