By application accepted for filing December 14, 2001, Hosameldin Mohamed Osman, trading as Ahmed Medical Transportation (Osman), WMATC Carrier No. 505, and Ahmed Medical Transportation, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation (AMTI) (collectively applicants), seek Commission approval to transfer Certificate of Authority No. 505 from Osman to AMTI. Osman is an officer of AMTI.

AMTI proposes commencing operations with five vans to be acquired from Osman. AMTI's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

Article XI, Section 11(a), of the Compact governs the transfer of assets, including a certificate of authority, by an unincorporated WMATC carrier in exchange for a controlling interest in a newly formed corporation.<sup>1</sup> A transfer of this nature raises fitness issues only.<sup>2</sup>

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether AMTI is fit.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicants shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than January 4, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicants shall file with the Commission, no later than January 25, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is January 25, 2002, and that copies must be served on transferee's director, Hosameldin Mohamed Osman, 2471 - 18<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20009.
