Pursuant to Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58-02, a WMATC certificate of authority is not valid unless an effective WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Endorsement) is on file with the Commission. The WMATC Endorsements on file for respondent expired October 1, 2001. Order No. 6380, issued in this proceeding on October 11, 2001, directed respondent to file effective replacements within thirty days or show good cause why respondent's certificate of authority should not be revoked.

According to Commission Regulation No. 58-03, the minimum required motor vehicle liability insurance for respondent is \$1.5 million. An acceptable WMATC Endorsement for \$1 million in primary coverage was filed with the Commission on October 12, 2001. To date, no acceptable WMATC Endorsement has been filed for the excess.<sup>1</sup>

Certificate No. 501 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact, the regulations thereunder and the initial order in this proceeding.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That Certificate of Authority No. 501 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph; and

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<sup>1</sup> A WMATC Endorsement for \$1 million in excess coverage filed with the Commission on October 29, 2001, is not acceptable because the issuer of the endorsement is unknown to the Commission and has not been identified by the underlying insurance company as authorized to issue WMATC Endorsements on the insurance company's behalf.

c. surrender Certificate No. 501 to the Commission.
