This investigation was initiated on January 7, 2002, in Order No. 6480. The Order directs respondents to produce on or before February 6, 2002, documents relating to their operations in the Metropolitan District since August 2, 2001.


On January 22, 2002, respondent Global Express Limousine filed a request for an "open hearing." On January 28, 2002, Commission staff met with representatives of Global Express Limousine to discuss the hearing request and the requirements of Order No. 6480. The discussion also included staff's review of a draft application for operating authority filed by respondents on November 5, 2001.

Global Express Limousine has since withdrawn the request for hearing and requested an extension of the response deadline until "the beginning of March." This is the first request for an extension of the response deadline.

In consideration of Global Express Limousine's good faith, as evidenced by the meeting with Commission staff, and the absence of any previous request for extension, for good cause shown, the request for an extension of the response deadline shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that respondents shall comply with Order No. 6480 on or before March 1, 2002.
