The certificate of insurance on file for Graham's Transportation Service, Inc., expired at 12:01 a.m. on February 8, 2002, triggering the invalidation and automatic suspension of Certificate No. 307 under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58-02.

The Commission issued Order No. 6543 on February 12, 2002, and therein directed respondent to file an appropriate certificate of insurance within 30 days or show cause why Certificate No. 307 should not be revoked.

On February 12, 2002, respondent filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 307.


The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder.

The application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 307 is hereby terminated, effective this date.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:
 - a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 307 to the Commission.
