By application accepted for filing March 4, 2002, Dynamic Tours, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van, two sedans, two minibuses, and four motorcoaches. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly charter rates, with minimum charges, individual and group sightseeing rates and airport transfer rates.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation and acquisition of control is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 22, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 12, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 12, 2002, and that copies must be served on applicant's vice president, Reuben M. Moore, 8901 Darcy Road, Upper Marlboro, MD 20774.
