By application accepted for filing March 8, 2002, applicant, Amory's Care Transportation Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks Commission approval to acquire Certificate No. 417 from Yeama Will, trading as Amory's Care Transportation. Will has agreed to transfer Certificate No. 417 and other assets in exchange for a controlling interest in Amory's Care Transportation Inc., a new carrier.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

Article XI, Section 11(a), of the Compact governs the transfer of a certificate of authority in exchange for a controlling interest in a new carrier.<sup>1</sup> A transfer of this nature raises fitness issues only.<sup>2</sup>

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 8, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 29, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 29, 2002, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Yeama Will, 13618 Hayworth Drive, Potomac, MD 20854.
