By application accepted for filing March 8, 2002, Global Express Limousine Service, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one minibus and one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly charter rates, with minimum charges.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation and acquisition of control is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 8, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 29, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 29, 2002, and that copies must be served on applicant's executive vice president, Jonathan Ger, 15843 Crabbs Branch Way, Rockville, MD 20855.
