This matter is before the Commission on the motion of respondent BMG Limousine and Jet Service, LLC, filed April 3, 2002, for an extension of time to respond to Commission Order No. 6558, served March 4, 2002.


The order gave respondents fifteen days to request an oral hearing and thirty days to show cause why Certificate of Authority No. 515 should not be revoked. The motion seeks an extension of the thirty-day show-cause deadline until April 15, 2002.

In support, the motion states that respondent BMG Limousine and Jet Service, LLC, has been working diligently to respond to Order No. 6558 but will be unable to compile all relevant documentation for submission to the Commission by April 3, 2002. Further, the motion states that counsel for respondent OAO Corporation does not oppose the request for additional time. This is the first request for an extension of the show-cause deadline.

In consideration of the grounds urged in the motion and the absence of any previous request for extension, for good cause shown, the request for an extension of the show-cause deadline shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that respondents shall have until April 15, 2002, to show cause why Certificate of Authority No. 515 should not be revoked.
