By application accepted for filing February 27, 2002, National Transportation of Washington, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with four minibuses. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly charter rate and transfer rates.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 26, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 17, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is May 17, 2002, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Eric J. Chapman, 2020 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., #290, Washington, DC 20006.
