

On May 2, 2002, in Order No. 6636, the Commission directed applicant to file updated financial statements in connection with our assessment of applicant's fitness for a certificate of authority. We had previously found applicant fit and issued a conditional grant of operating authority, but by the time applicant satisfied our conditions, applicant's financial information had grown stale, nullifying our finding of financial fitness.<sup>1</sup>

To establish financial fitness, an applicant must show the present ability to sustain operations during the first year under WMATC authority.<sup>2</sup> Applicant's balance sheet dated March 31, 2002, shows \$249,434 in current assets and \$81,602 in current liabilities. Applicant is projecting a net profit of \$100,000 during calendar year 2002. We have found other applicants fit under similar circumstances.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Authority No. 510 shall be issued to Westview Medical & Rehabilitation Services, P.C. Inc., 3200 - 12th Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20017.
