By application accepted for filing July 17, 2002, Glory Transports, LLC, a Maryland limited liability company, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

Applicant's balance sheet, Exhibit A, shows \$3,019 in cash but no other current assets, such as prepaid insurance. Applicant will be directed to explain how it proposes to obtain insurance, pay other start-up costs and establish a sufficient reserve for contingencies with only \$3,019.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 9, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 30, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 9, 2002, an original and four copies of a written statement that explains how applicant proposes to obtain insurance, pay other start-up costs and establish a sufficient reserve for contingencies with only \$3,019.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 30, 2002, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Nana B. Owusu, CPA, 644 H Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20002.
