By application accepted for filing July 12, 2002, Hassan El Hassan Ahmed, a sole proprietor trading as Mini Transportation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van and two sedans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for exclusive service and shared-ride service in sedans and vans, including rates for van transportation under the DC Medicaid program, an hourly rate for charter van service, and per capita fares for van transportation to and from Union Station, Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport and Washington-Dulles International Airport.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 9, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 30, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 30, 2002, and that copies must be served on applicant at 3015 Spice Court, Vienna, VA 22181.
