
This proceeding was initiated on June 6, 2002, in Order No. 6685. The order noted that respondent was not in compliance with the Commission's requirements relating to insurance and annual fees. The order gave respondent thirty days to file an effective certificate of insurance and pay an annual fee of \$100, or show good cause why its certificate of authority should not be revoked. To date, the Commission has received no response to Order No. 6685.

Certificate No. 33 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with: (1) Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58, governing insurance; and (2) Article IV, Section 4(a), of the Compact, Regulation No. 67 and Order No. 3601, governing annual fees.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 33 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 33 to the Commission.
