The certificate of insurance on file for Danny Transportation, Inc., expired July 25, 2002, triggering the invalidation and automatic suspension of Certificate No. 281 under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58-02. Order No. 6752, issued on July 29, 2002, directed Danny to file an effective insurance certificate within thirty days or show good cause why its certificate of authority should not be revoked. To date, Danny has neither filed an effective insurance certificate nor shown good cause why Certificate No. 605 should not be revoked.


Certificate No. 605 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact, the regulations thereunder and Order No. 6752.

Order No. 6752 also directed Danny to file an annual report for 2001 and pay the \$100 annual fee for 2002. Danny has yet to comply. Order Nos. 6777 and 6778 issued on August 16, 2002, in Case Nos. MP-2002-75 and MP-2002-89, assessed a combined forfeiture of \$200 against Danny for failing to file the report and pay the fee when originally due. Danny has yet to pay the assessed forfeitures. Case Nos. MP-2002-75 and MP-2002-89, shall be terminated, provided that in the event Certificate No. 605 is later reinstated the requirement to file an annual report for 2001, pay the \$100 annual fee for 2002, and pay the combined \$200 civil forfeiture assessed in Order Nos. 6777 and 6778 likewise shall stand reinstated.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 605 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 605 to the Commission.
3. That Case Nos. MP-2002-75 and MP-2002-89 are hereby terminated.
