Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure its operations for a minimum of \$5 million<sup>1</sup> and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Endorsement). More than one WMATC Endorsement must be filed if the \$5 million is spread over two or more insurance policies.

The \$5 million WMATC Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on September 26, 2002. A replacement WMATC Endorsement filed September 25, 2002, shows coverage of \$1.5 million, leaving applicant \$3.5 million short. As a consequence, Certificate No. 254 is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02.

Respondent shall have thirty days to file one or more WMATC Endorsements in the amount of \$5 million. Certificate No. 254 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, if respondent fails to timely comply.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent is hereby directed to cease and desist from conducting transportation subject to the Compact, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That within thirty days, respondent shall file one or more WMATC Endorsements in the minimum amount of \$5 million.

3. That respondent's certificate of authority shall be revoked if respondent fails to timely comply with this order.

<sup>1</sup> The Commission approved respondent's application to add a seating capacity restriction to Certificate No. 254 on September 24, 2002, in Order No. 6817. Once respondent has satisfied the conditions of approval specified in that order, the seating capacity restriction will be added to Certificate No. 254, and the minimum insurance required under Certificate No. 254 will drop from \$5 million to \$1.5 million. In the meantime, Certificate No. 254 remains unrestricted, and the minimum insurance required under Certificate No. 254 remains \$5 million.
