Certificate No. 583 has been suspended since September 16, 2002, pursuant to Commission Order Nos. 6777 and 6778, served August 16, 2002, for respondent's willful failure to file an annual report for 2001, pay the \$100 annual fee for 2002, and pay the \$200 in civil forfeitures assessed in Order Nos. 6777 and 6778. Under those orders, respondent has until October 16, 2002, to show cause why Certificate No. 583 should not be revoked.

In the meantime, the insurance certificates on file for respondent were cancelled effective October 6, 2002, and have not been replaced as required by Commission Regulation No. 58.

Pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, respondent shall have thirty days to file effective insurance certificates or show cause why Certificate No. 583 should not be revoked. This does not extend the time to comply with Order Nos. 6777 and 6778, however.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent is directed to file an effective certificate of insurance within thirty days or show good cause why its certificate of authority should not be revoked.

2. That this order does not extend the time to comply with Order Nos. 6777 and 6778.

3. That respondent may file within 15 days from the date of this order a request for oral hearing, specifying the grounds for the request, describing the evidence to be adduced and explaining why such evidence cannot be adduced without an oral hearing.
