By application accepted for filing October 8, 2002, Becton's Elite Getaway, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with three motorcoaches. Applicant's proposed tariff contains airport transfer rates and an hourly charter rate with a minimum charge.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 1, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 22, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 22, 2002, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Larry D. Becton, 6908 Kingston Drive, Temple Hills, MD 20748.
