These proceedings were initiated on August 16, 2002, in Order Nos. 6777 and 6778 for the purpose of investigating the failure of Answers, Inc., WMATC Carrier No. 488, to file its annual report for 2001 and pay a \$100 annual fee for 2002.

Together, the orders gave respondent until September 16, 2002, to file the annual report, pay the annual fee, and pay a combined civil forfeiture of \$200 or show cause why a civil forfeiture should not be assessed. The orders further provided that upon respondent's failure to timely comply, Certificate No. 488 would be automatically suspended.

On October 2, 2002, the Commission revoked Certificate No. 488 for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact, the regulations thereunder and Order No. 6756.¹


Accordingly, these proceedings shall be terminated, provided that in the event Certificate No. 488 is later reinstated the requirement to file an annual report for 2001, pay the \$100 annual fee

for 2002, and pay the combined \$200 civil forfeiture assessed in Order Nos. 6777 and 6778 likewise shall stand reinstated.²
