
This investigation was initiated on September 20, 2002, in Order No. 6810. The order required each respondent to produce by October 21, 2002, any and all records in his or its possession, custody or control relating to operations in the Metropolitan District during the relevant period. In respondent Gillison's case the relevant period is August 5, 1999, to September 20, 2002.

On October 21, 2002, respondent William E. Gillison filed a request to extend the document production deadline to November 15, 2002. Gillison explains that some of the requested documents are being used to complete a quarterly fuel tax report due October 31, 2002.

In consideration of the foregoing and the absence of any previous request for extension, for good cause shown, the document production deadline shall be extended to November 15, 2002. No further extensions shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that respondent shall comply with Order No. 6810 on or before November 15, 2002.
