By application accepted for filing October 31, 2002, MV Transportation, Inc., a California corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District. Applicant also has applied for temporary authority in Case No. AP-2002-125.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with 73 vehicles pursuant to a contract with Fairfax County, Virginia, to manage and operate a portion of the County's FASTRANS paratransit service.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than December 2, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 23, 2002, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is December 23, 2002, and that copies must be served on applicant's general manager, Chris York, 12011 Government Center Parkway, Suite 1032.1, Fairfax, VA 22035.
