By application accepted for filing November 15, 2002, Jet Tours USA, Inc., a New Jersey corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.¹

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita sightseeing rates, per capita transfer rates, with and without sightseeing, and a group sightseeing fare.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than December 27, 2002, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than January 17, 2003, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

¹ Applicant held WMATC Certificate of Authority No. 315 from October 17, 1995, to February 21, 2002, when it was revoked in Order No. 6551 for applicant's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact and regulations thereunder. In re Jet Tours USA, Inc., No. MP-02-06, Order No. 6551 (Feb. 21, 2002). A subsequent application to reinstate Certificate No. 315 was denied without prejudice for failure to demonstrate regulatory compliance fitness. In re Jet Tours USA, Inc., No. AP-02-94, Order No. 6878 (Oct. 30, 2002).

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is January 17, 2003, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Raymond S. Thomas, P. O. Box 333, Rutherford, NJ 07070.
