By application accepted for filing December 6, 2002, Sunny's Coach Services, Inc., a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.¹

Applicant proposes commencing operations with three buses. Applicant's proposed tariff contains a daily charter sightseeing rate, an hourly charter rate, with a minimum charge, and airport transfer rates.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than January 6, 2003, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than January 27, 2003, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is January 27, 2003, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Shafqat I. Chaudry, 4900 Leesburg Pike, #400, Alexandria, VA 22302-1108.
