
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 259 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on November 23, 2002, and Certificate No. 259 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 6916, served November 26, 2002.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on December 31, 2002 and an acceptable \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on January 3, 2003. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
