By application accepted for filing December 18, 2002, Yai Medical Transportation, L.L.C., a District of Columbia limited liability company, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains individual and group rates for transportation inside and outside the Capital Beltway.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than January 31, 2003, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 21, 2003, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is February 21, 2003, and that copies must be served on applicant's manager, Nicolas Yai Weil, 629 Columbia Road, N.W., Washington, DC 20001.
