
Certificate No. 235 was automatically suspended on November 20, 2002, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02, for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 6914, served November 22, 2002, noted that Certificate No. 235 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) within thirty days. Respondent has yet to comply.

Accordingly, Certificate No. 235 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Regulation No. 58.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 235 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 235 to the Commission.
