
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 533 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

Order No. 6949, served December 12, 2002, revoked the \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent pursuant to Regulation No. 58-09, effective January 11, 2003. The order directed respondent to file within thirty days one or more new WMATC Endorsements in the minimum amount of \$1.5 million and a certificate of good standing from the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation. The order noted that Certificate No. 533 would be automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 upon respondent's failure to timely comply.

Respondent filed certificates of good standing from the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation and the DC Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs on January 16, 2003. A new \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement was accepted for filing on January 21, 2003. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
