
On March 19, 2003, in Order No. 7095, the Commission issued notice that the \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent would stand revoked effective April 18, 2003. The endorsement was executed by Burns & Wilcox Ltd., an underwriter for National Casualty Insurance Company. Accompanying the Endorsement was a Burns & Wilcox memo that appeared to modify the terms of the Endorsement.

Order No. 7095 noted that respondent would have thirty days to file a newly executed WMATC Insurance Endorsement and, if a National Casualty Endorsement executed by Burns & Wilcox, a separate written affirmation of National Casualty's commitment to pay claims in accordance with the Endorsement; otherwise, Certificate No. 526 would be automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02, and subject to revocation pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

On March 24, 2003, the Commission received a newly executed \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement from Burns & Wilcox and a new Burns & Wilcox memo indicating without qualification that the newly executed Endorsement, which the memo refers to as a certificate, "supercedes all previous certificates and memos." Accordingly, this proceeding is terminated.
