

This proceeding was initiated on March 19, 2002, in Order No. 7099 for the purpose of inspecting respondents' twenty-four revenue vehicles. Respondents were given thirty days to produce all of their revenue vehicles for inspection by Commission staff. The order further provided that: (1) any vehicle(s) which failed inspection could not be operated until such time that the vehicle(s) passed reinspection; and (2) failure to timely comply with the conditions of the order would result in suspension of respondents' operating authority.

All of respondents' vehicles have been presented for inspection, and all have now passed. Accordingly, this proceeding is terminated.
