Case No. MP-2003-17

Certificate No. 303 was automatically suspended on February 27, 2003, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02, for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 7061, served February 27, 2003, noted that Certificate No. 303 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) within thirty days. Respondent has yet to comply.

Accordingly, Certificate No. 303 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Regulation No. 58 and Order No. 7061.

In addition, respondent has neither paid the \$100 annual fee for 2003, as required by Article IV, Section 4(a), Regulation No. 67 and Order No. 3601, nor filed an annual report for 2002, as required by Article XII, Section 1(a), Regulation No. 60-01 as amended by Order No. 4174, and Commission letter dated January 15, 2003.


In the event Certificate No. 303 is later reinstated, the requirement to pay the \$100 annual fee for 2003 and file an annual report for 2002 shall still apply.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 303 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and

c. surrender Certificate No. 303 to the Commission.
