By application accepted for filing April 25, 2003, R.A.J. Transportation LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly charter rate and individual fares for one-way and round-trip service.

The proposed individual fares include two sets of fares for intra-DC service. The fares on Line 1 of Exhibit B apply to "All trips D.C. to D.C." The fares on Line 4 of Exhibit B apply to "Private pay ambulatory trips (within D.C. ONLY)." Obviously, if one set of fares applies to all trips in DC specifying a second set creates a conflict. Applicant will be directed to submit an amended proposed tariff resolving the conflict between the intra-DC fares on Line 1 of Exhibit B and the intra-DC fares on Line 4 of Exhibit B.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 22, 2003, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 12, 2003, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 22, 2003, an original and four copies of an amended proposed tariff resolving the conflict between the intra-DC fares on Line 1 of Exhibit B and the intra-DC fares on Line 4 of Exhibit B.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 12, 2003, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Raymond A. Johnson, 2700 Q Street, S.E., #203, Washington, DC 20020-3943.
