On April 19, 2003, Certificate No. 161 was automatically suspended pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02 for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58.

On April 23, 2003, in Order No. 7141, the Commission served notice on respondent that Certificate No. 161 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) within thirty days. Later that same day, respondent filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 161.

Because respondent is not in good standing with the Commission, having neither paid the \$100 annual fee for 2003 nor filed its annual report for 2002,<sup>1</sup> we shall deny the application for voluntary termination. Because respondent has failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), we shall revoke Certificate No. 161 pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Regulation No. 58.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application for voluntary termination is denied.
2. That Certificate of Authority No. 161 is hereby revoked.



<sup>1</sup> Commission Order No. 3601 states that each carrier holding authority on the first day of the year shall pay a \$100 annual fee for that year on or before January 31. Pursuant to Article XII, Section 1(a), Commission Regulation No. 60-01 as amended by Order No. 4174, and Commission letter dated January 15, 2003, respondent's 2002 annual report was due on or before January 31, 2003.

3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 161 to the Commission.
