By application filed June 3, 2003, Precis Corporation, a Maryland corporation, seeks temporary authority to conduct shuttle operations between points in the District of Columbia and between the District of Columbia and Northern Virginia under a contract with the Department of Defense (DOD). Applicant has also applied for a certificate of authority in Case No. AP-2003-71.

It appears that applicant proposes commencing operations with six minibuses. It further appears that applicant will acquire them from the previous operator of the DOD contract, LCG, Inc., trading as Laurel Consulting Group, WMATC Carrier No. 375.<sup>1</sup> Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit A confirming the number of vehicles applicant will operate under the DOD contract, stating from whom those vehicles will be acquired and explaining whether those vehicles will be acquired by purchase or by lease.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 13(a), the Commission may grant temporary authority if there is an immediate need for service that is not available. Under Regulation No. 54-06(a), a temporary authority applicant must demonstrate fitness.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether there is an immediate need for service that is not available.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 7, 2003, an original and four copies of an amended Exhibit A confirming the number of vehicles applicant will operate under the DOD contract, stating from whom those vehicles will be acquired and explaining whether those vehicles will be acquired by purchase or by lease.

<sup>1</sup> LCG is currently operating buses over the DOD routes pursuant to a subcontract with applicant.

2. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 21, 2003, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, William H. McGlockton, II, 1400 Mercantile Lane, Suite 160, Largo, MD 20774.
