
Certificate No. 74 has been suspended since May 20, 2003, pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58-02, for respondent's willful failure to replace the terminated \$1.5 million primary and \$3.5 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements.

On the day of the suspension respondent applied to lower the minimum insurance requirement to \$1.5 million by adding a 15-person seating capacity restriction to Certificate No. 74. Two days later, on May 22, 2003, respondent filed a \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement. Respondent's application was conditionally approved in Order No. 7208 on May 28, 2003.¹

Respondent has satisfied all of the conditions specified in Order No. 7208, and Certificate No. 74 has been amended to include a 15-person seating capacity restriction, thereby lowering the minimum insurance requirement to \$1.5 million. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
