
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 701 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on June 26, 2003, and Certificate No. 701 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 7276, served June 27, 2003.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on July 14, 2003. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
