By Order No. 7228, served June 4, 2003, the Commission revoked Certificate of Authority No. 524 pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission an effective WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement. Respondent subsequently filed acceptable replacement endorsements and an application for reconsideration of Order No. 7228.


Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within thirty days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration.

Respondent timely filed the application for reconsideration on June 24, 2003, but the application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.<sup>1</sup>

However, because respondent has filed acceptable replacement endorsements showing reinstatement of full coverage, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 524.<sup>2</sup>

IT IS SO ORDERED.
