By application accepted for filing August 1, 2003, Nagwa Mohamed Hamad, a sole proprietor trading as Amna Midical Care Transportation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

Applicant plans to lease its revenue vehicle from Salahedin Mohamed Hamad, a sole proprietor trading as Nasrin Medical Transportation, WMATC No. 686. Also, applicant's designated agent is Elfatih Eltahir Ali, a sole proprietor trading as Metro Transporters, who has applied for a certificate of authority in Case No. AP-2003-89. Applicant will be directed to file a statement explaining her relationship with Mr. Hamad and Mr. Ali.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 21, 2003, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 11, 2003, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 21, 2003, an original and four copies of a statement explaining the relationship between applicant and Salahedin Mohamed Hamad, trading as Nasrin Medical Transportation, and the relationship between applicant and Elfatih Eltahir Ali, trading as Metro Transporters.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is September 11, 2003, and that copies must be served on applicant at 3101 S. Manchester Street, #519, Falls Church, VA 22044-2726.
