
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 463 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on September 23, 2003. Respondent filed a \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on August 8, 2003, but no excess endorsement was filed. Certificate No. 463 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 7424, served September 26, 2003.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on October 1, 2003. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
