
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 376 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

On September 4, 2003, respondent filed a WMATC Insurance Endorsement for \$1.5 million in primary coverage from the Progressive Casualty Insurance Company (Progressive). On September 29, 2003, the Progressive endorsement was terminated by replacement when respondent filed a WMATC Insurance Endorsement for \$1.5 million in primary coverage from Liberty Mutual Insurance Company (Liberty Mutual). On October 6, 2003, the Commission received notice from Progressive that the Progressive policy was still active.

Order No. 7461, served October 10, 2003, gave respondent thirty days to file proof that one of the policies had been cancelled and a new WMATC Insurance Endorsement for the other. The Commission received a notice of cancellation from Progressive on October 16, 2003, and an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement from Liberty Mutual on October 29, 2003. Accordingly, this investigation is terminated.
