
This proceeding was initiated on September 26, 2003, in Order No. 7425. The order noted that respondent was not in compliance with the Commission's requirements relating to insurance, annual fees and annual reports. The order gave respondent thirty days to file an effective WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), pay the annual fee of \$100 for 2003, and submit an annual report for 2002, or show good cause why Certificate No. 185 should not be revoked. To date, the Commission has received no response to Order No. 7425.<sup>1</sup>

Certificate No. 185 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with: (1) Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58, governing insurance; (2) Article IV, Section 4(a), of the Compact, Regulation No. 67 and Order No. 3601, governing annual fees; and (3) Article XII, Section 1(a), of the Compact, Regulation No. 60-01 as amended by Order No. 4174, and Commission letter dated January 15, 2003, governing annual reports.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 185 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding paragraph; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 185 to the Commission.

This order shall not be construed to excuse respondent from complying with the orders issued in those proceedings.
