Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 529 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on November 7, 2003. A \$3 million excess of \$2 million replacement endorsement was filed November 7, 2003, but no endorsement was filed for the first \$2 million. The excess endorsement was not acceptable in any event because the carrier name did not match the carrier name on file with the Commission.<sup>1</sup> Certificate No. 562 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 7528, served November 10, 2003.

Respondent subsequently filed an acceptable \$3 million excess of \$2 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement on November 14, 2003, and an acceptable \$2 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on November 17, 2003. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
