This matter is before the Commission on the failure of Faith Transportation, Inc., to respond to Order No. 7458, served October 7, 2003.

Order No. 7458 gave Faith Transportation, Inc., thirty days to show cause why Certificate No. 377 should not be revoked for willful failure to produce documents relevant to the Commission's investigation into Faith Transportation, Inc.'s operations in the Metropolitan District and to produce vehicles for inspection, as commanded by Order No. 7256, served June 20, 2003. Order No. 7458 also gave Faith Transportation, Inc., fifteen days to request a hearing. To date, Faith Transportation, Inc., has still not complied with Order No. 7256 and has neither requested a hearing nor offered any explanation for failing to comply with Order No. 7256.

Under Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, the Commission, after notice and hearing, may suspend or revoke a certificate of authority for a carrier's willful failure to comply with a provision of the Compact or an order or regulation of the Commission.


Inasmuch as Faith Transportation, Inc., has failed to offer any explanation for failing to cooperate with the Commission's investigation, we shall revoke Certificate No. 377.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 377 is hereby revoked for willful failure to comply with Order No. 7256.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and

c. surrender Certificate No. 377 to the Commission.
