
Certificate No. 290 was automatically suspended on November 15, 2003, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02, for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 7542, served November 19, 2003, noted that Certificate No. 290 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) within thirty days.

On January 8, 2004, pursuant to Order No. 7316, served July 17, 2003, the Commission transferred Certificate No. 290 to Quiana Tours, Inc., after Quiana Tours, Inc., had, among other things, filed evidence of insurance pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58 and Order No. 4203, as mandated by Order No. 7316.

Accordingly, this proceeding is terminated.
