
This application was accepted for filing on December 3, 2003. Applicant submitted a change of mailing address on January 5, 2004. The Commission wrote to applicant on January 28, 2004, advising applicant to confirm his street address on or before February 5, 2004, or face dismissal of this application. Applicant has yet to respond.

An application for a certificate of authority must be in writing, verified, and in the form and with the information that Commission regulations require.¹ Commission Regulation No. 54 requires an applicant to complete and file the Commission's application form. The form requires an applicant to specify his current street address. Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.²

Inasmuch as applicant has failed to confirm his current street address, the application shall be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Amin Abdelhafiz, trading as Dolly Trans, is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
