Notice of this application was served on January 20, 2004, in Order No. 7680. Applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 3, 2004, and furnish additional information in support of the application no later than February 24, 2004. The deadline for comments and protests also was set at February 24, 2004.

On February 10, 2004, applicant filed a request for an extension of the publication deadline. This is applicant's first such request. The publication deadline shall be extended as requested. A new deadline will be set for filing protests and additional information in support of the application.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than March 3, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 24, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.


3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 24, 2004, an original and four copies of a current certificate of good standing.

4. That Mr. Lee and Mr. Huang shall file with the Commission, no later than March 24, 2004, an original and four copies of a notarized affidavit verifying the removal of Regulation No. 61 markings from the revenue vehicles of Traveland International Inc. and stating when the markings were removed.

5. That Mr. Lee and Mr. Huang shall surrender Certificate No. 372 to the Commission on or before March 24, 2004.

6. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is March 24, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's vice president, Henry Huang, 113 Talbott Street, Rockville, MD 20852.
