
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 592 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on February 19, 2004. A \$5 million replacement endorsement filed on February 19, 2004, was unacceptable for filing because the carrier address on the endorsement did not match the carrier address on file with the Commission.¹ Certificate No. 592 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 7761, served February 20, 2004.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on February 24, 2004. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
