
This proceeding was initiated on January 23, 2004, in Order No. 7690 for the purpose of investigating respondent's failure to file an amended tariff specifying current DC Medicaid rates. The order gave respondent until February 22, 2004, to file an amended tariff, pay a filing fee of \$25 and pay a civil forfeiture of \$100. The order provided that, in the alternative, respondent would have until February 22, 2004, to show cause why an amended tariff need not be filed. The order also provided that Certificate No. 620 would stand suspended and be subject to revocation upon respondent's failure to timely comply.

On January 29, 2004, the Commission revoked Certificate No. 620 for respondent's willful failure to comply with Article XI, Section 6(a), of the Compact, Commission Regulation Nos. 58 and 60, and Commission Order Nos. 7469 and 7525.¹

Given that Certificate No. 620 has been revoked but that respondent has not responded to Order No. 7690, this proceeding shall be terminated with the understanding that the forfeiture assessed in Order No. 7690 shall remain payable.
