Case No. MP-2004-48 was initiated on January 23, 2004, in Order No. 7690 for the purpose of investigating respondent's failure to file an amended tariff specifying current DC Medicaid rates. The order provided that Certificate No. 729 would stand suspended and be subject to revocation if respondent did not file the amended tariff, pay a filing fee of \$25 and pay a civil forfeiture of \$100, on or before February 22, 2004.

Certificate No. 729 was suspended on February 1, 2004, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02, for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Order No. 7729, served February 3, 2004, in Case No. MP-2004-61, noted that Certificate No. 729 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) on or before March 4, 2004.


On February 25, 2004, in Case No. MP-2004-48, the Commission issued Order No. 7795 giving respondent until March 26, 2004, to either file the amended tariff and pay the filing fee and forfeiture assessed in Order No. 7690 or show cause why Certificate No. 729 should not be revoked.

Because respondent has failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), and because payment of the forfeiture assessed in Order No. 7690 is still outstanding, Certificate No. 729 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Regulation No. 58; provided, that the forfeiture assessed in Order No. 7690 shall remain due and payable.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Cases Nos. MP-2004-48 and MP-2004-61 are hereby consolidated.
2. That Certificate of Authority No. 729 is hereby revoked.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 729 to the Commission.
