

This matter is before the Commission on respondent's response to Commission Order No. 7878, served March 19, 2004, which gave respondent thirty days to pay a \$1,000 civil forfeiture. On April 2, 2004, respondent tendered a cashier's check payable to the Commission for \$1,000.

In accordance with Commission Order No. 7878, the suspension of Certificate No. 401 is hereby lifted, subject to a one-year period of probation, such that a willful violation of the Compact, or of the Commission's rules, regulations or orders thereunder, during the period of probation shall constitute grounds for immediate revocation of Certificate No. 401, regardless of the nature and severity of the violation.
